Poster Materials and Guidelines	<p>The designs must be a black outline, as found in most coloring books. Entries must be done in marker, crayon, or ink only. No collages or computer Generated/enhanced art, please.</p> <p>All entries must have a 50 word (or less) explanation of what that design is and how it relates to the watershed (the natural area between the bluffs and the river, including all streams that go into the river) and people. The 50 word explanation could be a description or conservation tip, but should be in the student's words.</p> <p>Entries must be done on 8.5" x 11" heavy art paper or poster board. The winning art will be reproduced into a coloring book, so only entries following the guidelines will be accepted.</p> <p>Entries must have student's name, school, and phone number on the back.</p>
Deadline	Artwork can be submitted to your teacher, youth group leader, or they can be mailed or dropped off at the Alton Marketplace Association office (100 East Broadway; Alton, IL. 62002) by Friday, September 04, 2009. No late entries will be accepted.
